3. Matters Not Anticipated by the Chair:

(a) Receive Updated Status on Various Outstanding Projects by the Business Administrator
Susan Bottan and Mabel Reid-Wallace asked the Finance Subcommittee's advice regarding an opportunity that
was raised today. METCO students have the opportunity to participate in the Black College Tour. The School
District learned today that Wayland could receive additional funds from the state grant to help fund students'
participation in this tour. However, given the District's purchase order process, payment cannot be made in time.
Therefore, Susan recommended that the school credit card be used to secure two spaces for approximately \$1,800.
She would issue a requisition to the company, encumber the funds, use the credit card to make payment and then
charge the grant. The Subcommittee asked about the process for selecting which students would be able to
participate. Mabel indicated that two Boston students had expressed an interest but had not been able to
participate for financial reasons. These funds would allow these two students to attend the Black College Tour. No
further concerns were raised by the Subcommittee.
