1. <u>Receive Budget Policy Recommendations from Unibank Fiscal Advisory Services:</u>

Unibank Fiscal Advisory Services presented a proposed budget policy for the Town of Wayland. The policy was drafted for several reasons including maintaining the town's AAA bond rating, less reliance on debt and level funding of debt services, discontinuing the use of free cash to help fund the operating budget, and funding OPEB from the operating budget.

The public was invited to comment and ask questions about the policy. Topics included the process for voting the policy, what happens if the AAA bond rating is lost, the stabilization fund, free cash, and financial modeling.
